Welcome to the 360 Degrees Case Study Competition! Here's an in-depth look at the guidelines to ensure you make the most out of this exciting opportunity.

- The competition is open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students from any college or university.
- · Participants should be part of a team of 1-3 members.
- The team leader should register on behalf of the entire team, specifying the team's name, and details of other team members.
- · Inter college teams are not allowed.
- · There will be no registration fee for the event.
- The event will be conducted in 3 rounds and completely online.
- The first round will be an online prelims test. This test consists of mental ability and logical reasoning questions. Teams will be shortlisted to the next round based on their scores.
- The second round will be a case study round in which participants need to submit their solutions to a given case.
- . Winners should bring their respective College ID Cards along with them on the Summit Day to verify their identity and collect the cash prize.
- The third and final round also will be a case study solving round and the final winners will be chosen after this round.
- The submissions to the case studies should be submitted as pdfs of powerpoint slides.
- The submissions should be done within the given deadlines and marks will be deducted for late submissions. A deduction of 20% of the total marks will be applied for each additional day beyond the specified deadline for project submission.
- The projects will be judged on the following criteria:
 - o Analysis and Problem Solving
 - o Presentation Skills

- Teams will be regularly contacted via mail by the organising committee.
- · All decisions in matters of eligibility, authenticity, and final judgments will be with the organising committee, IEDC NIT Calicut.
